What is amazing is that the pastors present sent for their indigenous missionaries in the north before the meeting was over and are having Youlou stay an extra 3 or 4 days to train on how to facilitate Live School! They will return to train others with Live School in the far north to reach the harvest there. This is a special *kairos* time for Congo! God is blanketing Congo with Live School from the north to the south of the country so quickly! The harvest there must be **GREAT!**

When Youlou trains them on how to operate Live School, he also is briefing them on how to properly train the students to use Farming God's Way and seeing great success! He has captured the vision and is RUNNING with it!



A CHRISTIAN HIGH SCHOOL IN A MUSLIM AREA


